

# Camp Nahaco Park Commission

## **RULES and REGULATIONS**

The Rules and Regulations set forth herein shall apply to and be in effect for the **Camp Nahaco**, under the control, supervision and jurisdiction of the Towns of Eastford and Woodstock and administered by the *Camp Nahaco Park Commission*.

### **Admission to the Park Hours of Closing.**

A. The park shall be closed from sunset to sunrise.

B. No person shall be permitted to remain, stop or park within the confines of the park between sunset and sunrise except, in an emergency or with special written permission from the Camp Nahaco Park Commission. In an emergency situation or when the public interest demands it, any portion of the park may be closed to the public or designated persons until it is deemed prudent to allow readmission.

### **Permits.**

A.A permit or license must be obtained from the Camp Nahaco Park Commission for the following:

- (1) The exclusive use of park lodges, buildings or pavilions.
- (2) The exclusive use of playfields or other open areas.
- (3.) Overnight camping.
- (4) The vending of food or drink.
- (5) The consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- (6) The use of the park by a for-profit organization.

### **Park Regulations.**

A. No person shall injure, deface, disturb, befoul or remove any part of a Park building, equipment, tables, benches, railings, fences, signs, boundary markers or any other property found therein; nor shall any tree, flower, shrub, rock or natural element be removed, injured or destroyed without express written permission of the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

B. No person within the confines of the park shall hunt, trap, possess or molest any wildlife without express written permission of the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

C. No person shall use, carry, possess, or discharge firearms of any kind, or have air or gas powered guns, paintball guns, crossbows or bows, fireworks or pyrotechnic display devices, or other projectile-

throwing devices, or weapons any kind within the park without the express written permission of the Camp Nahaco Park Commission, with the exception of duly authorized law enforcement personnel in the performance of their duties.

D. No person shall beg, hawk, peddle or solicit within the Park without express written permission of the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

E. No individual or organization shall conduct, sponsor or promote any planned or special event in the Park without the express written permission of the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

F. No person shall disturb other Park users by causing excessive levels of noise and/or use threatening, abusive, or insulting language.

G. No person shall litter.

H. No person shall climb on any wall, fence, building, tree or other structure.

I. Dogs, cats and other domestic pets are allowed in the Park if held under control by leash. Any persons bringing pets into the Park are responsible for cleaning up after them.

J. No person shall bathe, wade, dive or swim in the park or swimming area except at such times and in such areas as designated by the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

K. The riding of a horse shall only be allowed on trails designated for riding by the Camp Nahaco Park Commission.

L. No person shall operate any snowmobile, off-road motorbike, all-terrain, or other recreational vehicle in the Park. No person shall ride on the exterior of a vehicle. All registered vehicles shall be operated on designated roads only.

M. No vehicle shall be operated on any Park road at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour or in violation of any applicable Department of Motor Vehicles Regulations in the State of Connecticut.

N. Fishing is allowed in the Park in accordance with state statutes. No fishing is allowed in the swimming area.

O. Campfires are allowed only in established fire rings.

P. Any violation of these Rules and Regulations is punishable by the immediate removal of the violator from the premises and/or a minimum fine of \$100 per offense, and as otherwise provided for by law or ordinance of the Towns of Eastford and Woodstock, or the State of Connecticut.

Q. The invalidity of any section, provision, or portion of these rules and regulations shall not be construed to invalidate any other section, provision or portion thereof.
