John shared some of what the Federated Garden Club does. Philippa shared the idea of a Kids Camps for an hour or two on Saturday morning or a series of Saturday mornings. Philippa will reach out to Jay to discuss the possibility of partnering with the Woodstock Historical Society on an event.

John mentioned the split rail fence needs repair and will review what needs to be done. Also discussed needing to talk with Jesse about fence by her yard that is in disrepair.
