Upon arrival your day will begin with a tour of the Salem Witch Museum. This museum offers over 200 years of history of the infamous witch trials of a community that executed its own citizens for witchcraft. After touring the museum you will be free to explore the city on your own. Stroll the tree lined streets with cobbled walkways and browse the many specialty shops and galleries. Visit the historic seaport or have lunch at a waterfront restaurant. Salem offers many other historical sites and museums to fill your day before heading home to Woodstock.
