


Quasset School

The Quasset School was built in 1858 and originally sited on Wabaquasset Hill in the same location as an earlier schoolhouse built in 1748. In 1954, the school was moved to the grounds of the Woodstock Elementary School on Frog Pond Road to serve as a museum dedicated to the “beginning of American education.” For more information about the Quasset School, please visit the [Preservation Connecticut](#) website and the [Quasset School Advisory Committee](#) page on the Town of Woodstock website.
