- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:08 PM by Chair Kristen Heitert.
 - a. Regular members present: Kristen Heitert, Leila Philip, and Tom Chase. Quorum met.
 - b. Myron Stachiw joined the meeting at 6:35.
- 2. No alternates appointed for the meeting (none present).
- 3. Minutes of last-held regular meeting on March 22, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Tom Chase to approve them without changes. It was seconded by Leila Philip and passed unanimously.
- 4. No public comment.
- 5. Correspondence: Jean McClellan wrote to resign from the Commission, as did John Bartholomei. The Chair accepted their resignations with regret.
- 6. Old Business: None.
- 7. New Business: Discussion of potential projects for 2021-2022: It was proposed that the Woodstock Historic Properties Commission put on a lecture series for the public. The consensus was positive, and some possibilities were put forward.
