- 1. Call to order by Myra at 4:08 p.m.

- 4. Approve the minutes of the January 17, 2024. Motion by Greg seconded by Kate to approve the minutes of the Jan 17, 2024 meeting. Motion approved with corrections and no abstentions.
- **5.** Roof Mike was no able to attend today, but has the supplies and is waiting for better weather to spray the roof with the solution.
