Bull Hill

The drive up to Bull Hill's parking lot is a bit rough on a rutted dirt road, but there is an spacious parking lot just inside an old rusted gate. From here the trail starts on an undeveloped stretch of Bull Hill Rd. If you follow it you will eventually reach the other side in Grosvenordale. From the parking lot it's about .85 miles of wide rolling path that gradually climbs to the overlook. A long bench is set on the summit with a half ring of rocks. The view is nearly 360 degrees with the main view of South Woodstock and Roseland Lake.

Linda Rapaport Memorial

The Linda J. Rapoport Memorial Preserve owned by Wyndham Land Trust consists of 154 acres and has two parking: options near 287 Pulpit Rock Rd or at the end of Calkins Rd.

Trail length at this site is approximately 1.5 miles. Early spring or fall hiking is recommended as some parts of the trail are overgrown in full vegetation periods.







Cabbage Hill

From the small lot at the end of Cabbage Hill Road the trail starts off in a small field. There are several trails and sites including old gravestones on this 112 acre preserve.
