- A short artist bio

Pick up: Artwork should be picked up on September 16 from 3:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. (or by appointment)

Artwork Sales: All artwork sales will be facilitated by the gallery director and go through the artist. Artists are asked to make a gift of 30% back to The Woodstock Academy in the form of a check. Please write "gallery" in the memo.
